supreme ordinance of 17 De-
cember 1825, from the rights
vested in the undersigned authorities,
Ludwig Leonhard of
Jettenbach is granted the
desired release from the Royal Bavarian
bonds of allegiance and permission
for emigration to North America
with his wife Luisa geb. Göttel
and the children

To satisfy the esteemed directive of the 15th of
the previous month, one has the honor, upon
presentation of the prescribed, by the order of
the
16th of the previous month, herewith to report
obediently to the most honorable authority:
1, The claimant has already sold his entire estate
and from that has received 1900 G[ulden],
of which however the emigration-transfer
at 14 of 100 and the remaining burden
of the debts must be reduced after which
approximately 11-1200 G[ulden]
remains for him.
2, The above-named has three children, two
sons and a daughter;
 1, Daniel, born 6. January 1839.
 2, Ludwig, born 23. June 1841.
 3, Carolina, born 31. December 1843.
3, According to the enclosed testimonies of the
tax collector, the claimant has paid his taxes,
and the payment of the community monies has
been made a stipulation to the auctioneer of the
estate.
4, The office of legalization of the Bavarian

under the condition that
the above-named later provides
evidence of permanent acceptance
into the North American state.

Council [approves?] the enclosed ship's
contract.

5, The undersigned office is aware of nothing
against the planned emigration.
